### **About the Officer Kangaroos Junior Football Club**

#### **How it all Started**

Commencing in the 1999 football season the Rythdale-Officer-Cardinia (ROC) Senior Football Club began exploring options to expand its junior teams (it had at the time U13, U15 & U17 teams in the West Gippsland FL) as there was population growth expected in Officer and its surrounds, plus its neighboring clubs were already running junior teams in the DDJFL.

The Officer Kangaroos JFC were formed in 2001 with the help of the ROC FC committee, past players plus parents and players from the Brentwood Park Auskick Committee who were looking for a pathway for their boys and girls that had outgrown their Auskick years.

In 2001 the first two teams which were Under 10 and Under 12 took the field at the Starling Road ground under inaugural coaches were David Wing and Angelo Colosimo (see pic below).

# About the Officer Kangaroos Junior Football Club Today at Officer

Population growth in the district has seen an increase in participation numbers in our football and Auskick over the last four-five years.

In 2024 the Club will field 26 teams of approximately 535 registered players comprising of boys and girls from Under 8's to Under 19 Girls plus an AFL Victoria awarded Auskick Centre of 180 participants.

The Club runs a number of innovative programs, the Parklea Officer Junior Football Academy (pre-season and in season player and coaching development), Jump Start (Auskickers introduction to Under 8 and 9 footy), Not on My Watch (In conjunction with Beyond Blue) and the Club is a Good Sports Club (Gold Accredited).

The Officer Recreation Reserve on Starling Road – the home of the Club has undergone some major infrastructure improvements over the last four years – with more to come. These improvements ensure our players, and families can enjoy the most modern facilities available.

#### **Completed Projects**

- Complete re-construction of the original oval (known now as the Western Oval), which now faces North/South,
  with a superb all-weather surface, increased concourse, AFL sized goal posts, ball net and new coaches boxes
  [\$1.2M];
- A retrofit of the old change rooms to not only make them female friendly and acceptable to today's facility standards [\$650,000];
- New LED oval floodlights with a 150 lux capacity with capability to increase to 210 lux [\$235,000]
- New state of the art digital scoreboard [\$60,000];
- Solar panels with battery (ensuring lower electricity costs), dam expansion (to end the need for mains water when irrigating).
- New timekeepers box;
- New \$2.7M social rooms to cater for all the user groups football, cricket, tennis, netball.
