In September we held our successful presentation days at Inflatable World, Kemizo and our home RG Porter Rooms. In October we held our AGM with planning for 2023 beginning. November and December saw a number of players attend SEJ interleague sessions to enhance their skills and Dandenong Stingrays and Gippsland Power AFL pathway programs as part of their pre-season tryouts.

January was taken up confirming our Academy program which ran during February and March, leading into practice matches for our competitive age groups and Little Demons Day for our u8-10 teams. But everyone wants some more footy, so more practice matches were held in April before the school holidays, while some took a break, others were making final arrangements to ensure our kids can take the field.

Meanwhile, some players represented Casey and Melbourne Football Club in the Next Generation Academy matches, the Dandenong Stingrays and Gippsland Power in the opening rounds of the U16/U18 Coates talent league, and Vic Country in the U16 National Championships.

Fixturing

Fixtures are out for the first 4 rounds, which are the league grading rounds. After round 4, teams may be moved divisions accordingly.

Something new for this year, teams from Under 13s and up will play against teams in the South East Juniors and the Frankston District Juniors leagues, under the AFLSouth East competition banner. This will provide more competitive football and better development for all players in the region and has worked well in the U15s and up over the last 3 seasons.

2023 season

Some AFLSE, SEJ and Club rules/bylaws, you may not be aware of or have changed.

STOPPING AND RECOMMENCING TIME - The Timekeepers shall stop the clock which is used for the timing of a Match when directed to do so by a League Appointed Field Umpire (hand in the air and blows whistle).

CORRECT UNIFORM TO BE WORN - Full-length undergarments (items other than the playing jumper or shorts) may be worn

- temperature be below 10 degrees.
- Due to religious requirements
- The colour worn is required to be flesh colour or align with the team's colours.
- Short-sleeved or sleeveless undergarments are acceptable providing they are not visible.

INTERCHANGE BENCH - Extended to allow 8 players for all competitive age groups.

MATCH OFFICIALS - Sent off the ground or reported will incur a fine of up to \$500. The fine will be issued to the club and we will pass on to the match official to pay.

LEAGUE BEST & FAIREST - Will be awarded from U11 and up

REPORTED PLAYERS - A new matrix will determine the sanction available with a guilty plea (similar to AFL). The league can refer any incident directly to the tribunal. The club may issue a clubimposed sanction on top of any league sanction

WHAT HAS NOT CHANGED -
